- Horse Health Declaration Form must be handed in when collecting back numbers – NO FORM NO RIDE
- PIC Numbers MUST be on the nomination form or your nomination will not be accepted
- Performance cards (if applicable) to be handed to the nominations office prior to the commencement of event

RULES

1. No Smoking on the grounds
2. No Alcohol to be consumed on the grounds
3. All events will be run as per rule in current PCAQ RULE BOOK unless otherwise stated.
4. One horse per rider, One rider per horse
5. All riders must be in full Formal Pony Club uniform & must be a financial riding member of that club.
6. Riders are to remain with their group at all times.
7. Horses must be ridden at a walk at all times when not competing. This includes the car park areas.
8. Spectators shall not be allowed in the competition area.
9. DISPUTES: All complaints should be made to the Chief Steward – Carmen Coombs. Disputes committee will adjudicate accordingly. The complaint must be lodged in writing within 30 minutes & be accompanied by a fee of \$50.
10. By nominating for this Event competitors agree to allow Moggill Pony Club to use any photos taken of them at the Event for promotional purposes on their web
11. No dogs on the grounds.

RESERVATION OF RIGHT: The organising committee reserves the right to: cancel any class or event, combine classes if less than 3 competitors, or divide classes according to the numbers nominated and the rules governing splitting of groups, alter advertised times, transfer competitors between sections of a class, and to refuse any entry with or without stating a reason. If there are less than 3 competitive riders in a class or a combined class, the organising committee reserves the right to withhold the overall prize for that class.
