#### **THIS EVENT IS RUN IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PCQ RULES**

It is the responsibility of all riders/owners/lessee/competitors to be familiar with and aware of all Pony Club Australia rules.

**RESERVATION OF RIGHT** The Organisers reserve the right: (a) to cancel any class or event. (b) to divide any class. (c) to alter the advertised times (d) to refuse any entry, with or without stating the reason (e) to transfer competitors between sections of a class (f) to combine classes if less than 3 competitors.

**GENERAL RULES** All participants must comply with equipment and dress rules of Pony Club Queensland, specifically with regard to Saddlery, Helmets, Boots, Spurs and Equipment. Riders to wear light coloured jodhpurs, with collared T-Shirt / polo shirt with sleeves. No Jackets, Vests or Ties. Saddle cloth, dressage saddle cloth and numnahs of any colour or style are allowed. Plaiting encouraged, but not essential in the beginner ring.

#### **DOGS NOT ALLOWED ON THE GROUNDS.**

#### **NO STALLIONS PERMITTED**

**CONDUCT** Moggill Pony Club committee and ring attendants are all volunteers to the club and the hack show. Please respect that some of these volunteers have never attended an event of this nature before nor have they stewarded. Please be patient and polite whilst attending our event.

**ANNOUNCEMENTS** MPC upholds that it is the rider's responsibility to be ready for their class and aware of where the judge is up to in the program. Classes will not be held up for riders running late or changing mounts.

**WARM UP ARENA** MPC have provided a specific area to warm up only work your horses in this designated area. Only persons mounted on a horse or handler of a horse may enter this warm up area. All coaches and spectators must remain outside the warm up area. Lunging can only occur in the designated area and not within the sand warm up area.

#### **DEFINITIONS**

**BEGINNER RING:** This ring has been provided to allow riders new to the sport of Show Horse an opportunity to compete without the experience or the level of presentation of the open show horse arena. It is expected that competitors in this arena are inexperienced in all ridden disciplines and not competitors in other fields but new to show horse. Horses competing in the beginners ring are not eligible to compete in the open competition. Horses in this ring are not required to be plaited. Competitors must not have competed at any more than 1 Open Agricultural Show (district day not included) or 2 Hack shows, permission may be given for younger riders outside of these circumstances on request.

**MAIDEN:** Restricted to horses which have not won a hack class at an agricultural show except for district days (to be ridden in a snaffle bit only).

**FIRST RIDDEN PONY:** rider under 12yrs. Workout to include walk and trot, canter if rider suitably capable and confident. No disadvantage if no canter.

**NOVICE:** has not won a champion open at any other Royal Show, Agricultural show or hack day

**HUNTER:** A riding horse that demonstrates more substance than a show horse and is expected to demonstrate the ability to provide a smooth, even ride and reliable temperament. Mounts to be exhibited in plain browbands (no ribbon/bling browbands). Riders must exhibit their mounts as either hunter or hack not both.

**PROTESTS** MPC respect the judge's decision and uphold that the judge's decision is final. All protests are to be made in writing addressed to the Chief Steward with a fee of \$50 within 30mins of the event/class in question. Nominated fee is forfeited should the decision be upheld.

**BIOSECURITY** It is a requirement of the organising committee that competitors complete a horse health declaration and supply at nomination or collection of band for online nominations. No horse health declaration no compete.

**PARKING** No Cars without floats, other than officials will be allowed onto Moggill Pony Clubs Grounds. This is reserved for float parking only.
